

The Colgate Betty Fanning Postgraduate Scholarship - 2009

OBJECT

The object of this Postgraduate Scholarship is to assist a student to undertake a PhD at the University of Adelaide's Dental School in association with the Colgate Australian Clinical Dental Research Centre (CACDRC). Fields of research may include Dental Materials, Periodontal Regeneration, Bone Regeneration or Stem Cell Research and must be agreeable to Colgate-Palmolive Pty Ltd.

ELIGIBILITY

The Scholarship is open to Australian citizens and permanent residents. Non-residents may also apply however full tuition fees apply and are not covered by the Scholarship.

VALUE

The value of the Scholarship will be AUD\$20,007 (as per APA Award for 2007), payable as a tax-free stipend for a period of one year. Included in the Scholarship are a thesis allowance of \$500 and a research maintenance allowance of \$4,500.
