

# Good News for Students

## The University of Adelaide Graduate Diploma and Certificate Programs In 2010 these programs will be offered as Commonwealth Supported Places (CSPs)

Australian citizens, Permanent Humanitarian Visa Holders, Permanent residents and NZ citizens are eligible for Commonwealth Supported Places. The Commonwealth Government pays a contribution to the University for each CS student. The student also pays a contribution.

Student contribution is \$221.25 per unit of study. Total:

Graduate Diploma	\$5,310 (24 units)
Graduate Certificate	\$2,655 (12 units)

If you are eligible for a CSP and you pay your fees upfront (on or before census date) you will receive a discount of 20%. Thus:

Graduate Diploma	\$4,248
Graduate Certificate	\$2,124

Students who are eligible for a CSP may also defer their Student Contribution to a HECS-HELP loan with the Australian Taxation Office.

The amount paid is based on the study load (units enrolled) per semester.

### Continuing students

CSPs are available to all eligible students, both continuing and new.

The discount for CNAHS students will no longer apply but student contributions with the discount for upfront payments are lower than previous fees.

### External payments

Students are responsible for their payments.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If an external organisation is paying your student contribution this may attract Fringe Benefits Tax (FBT) if it is not paid by census date. This may significantly increase the amount to be paid. Please direct any enquiries regarding FBT to your external organisation.

It is advisable for students who are receiving funding from their organisation or a scholarship to arrange to pay the contribution personally and be reimbursed to ensure payment is received by census (31st March Semester 1, 31st August Semester 2).
