Comprehensive Ophthalmology Fellowship

The Fellowship is under the direction of Professor Selva, Dr Henry Newland & A/Professor Robert Casson at the Department of Ophthalmology & Visual Sciences, Royal Adelaide Hospital and Dr Michael Goggin, Department of Ophthalmology, the Queen Elizabeth Hospital.

The General Ophthalmology Fellowship is a self funded position available to overseas doctors wishing to gain further experience in all areas of ophthalmology.

The General Ophthalmic Fellow will begin the fellowship as an observer at the Royal Adelaide Hospital and the Queen Elizabeth Hospital whilst the consultants judge the level of experience and responsibility the fellow can handle. Observing will involve both clinical outpatients and theatre sessions. The program for this fellow is negotiable and depends on the interests of the person. The fellow will then be expected to run their own outpatient clinics.

There will be one research session per week during which the Fellow will be required to develop and complete several research projects in conjunction with the supervisors. Funding for presentations at an international meeting is also available. The Fellow is expected to be involved in the teaching of training registrars through tutorials and the OPD theatre.

Important Note: This position is usually booked at least two years in advance. Applications sent to the above postal address or email **will not** be considered unless the following minimum requirements are met:

Minimum Requirements:

- Graduate from an Ophthalmology Residency Program.

Overseas Applicants:

- Applicants that come from countries where English is not considered the first language must have passed an Academic **IELTS** with an overall score of no less than 7 and a minimum of 7 in each field. IELTS test results will not be considered if they are older than two years. (*Information regarding IELTS can be found on this site under English Proficiency*).

Applications must include:

- An up-to-date CV (including surgical experience and/or logbook).
- A detailed cover letter stating the position being applied for, past work experience, research interests and future plans.
- Pass Academic IELTS with overall minimum score of 7 or equivalent proof of English skills.
- Two written references from medical supervisors.
- Names, addresses, telephone, fax and email addresses of 3 referees.
- Applicant's address and contact details, including telephone, fax and email.
