Glaucoma Fellowship

The Fellowship is under the supervision of A/Prof Robert Casson and Dr. Anna Galanopoulos, Glaucoma Services, South Australian Institute of Ophthalmology, University of Adelaide. This is a Clinical/Research fellowship which involves an approximate 1:1 mix of research and clinical glaucoma. The Fellow is exposed to one glaucoma based operating session per week and 2 glaucoma clinics receiving one on one teaching. Opportunities exist for further theatre sessions (principally phaco) for a suitable candidate.

The Fellow will be involved with clinical and epidemiological glaucoma-based research and has the opportunity to be involved with glaucoma –based laboratory research if desired. Over the course of the year, the Fellow would perform 25-30 filtering surgeries independently. The Fellow is expected to be involved in the teaching of training registrars through tutorials and the OPD and theatre.

With research being an important part of the fellowship, the Fellow will have 2 research sessions per week during which he/she will be required to develop and complete several research projects in conjunction with the supervisors.

Important Note: This position is usually booked at least two years in advance. Applications sent to the above postal address or email **will not** be considered unless the following minimum requirements are met:

Minimum Requirements:

- Graduate from an Ophthalmology Residency Program.

Overseas Applicants:

- Applicants that come from countries where English is not considered the first language must have passed an Academic **IELTS** with an overall score of no less than 7 and a minimum of 7 in each field. IELTS test results will not be considered if they are older than two years. (*Information regarding IELTS can be found on this site under English Proficiency*).

Applications must include:

- An up-to-date CV (including surgical experience and/or logbook).
- A detailed cover letter stating the position being applied for, past work experience, research interests and future plans.
- Pass Academic IELTS with overall minimum score of 7 or equivalent proof of English skills.
- Two written references from medical supervisors.
- Names, addresses, telephone, fax and email addresses of 3 referees.
- Applicant's address and contact details, including telephone, fax and email.

Closing date for applications: 30th April each year
