## **Oculoplastic Fellowship**

The Fellowship is under the direction of Professor Selva and Dr Davis at the Oculoplastic, Lacrimal & Orbital Unit in the Department of Ophthalmology & Visual Sciences, Royal Adelaide Hospital. In total the Fellow is exposed to 5 operating sessions per week, including his/her own list. Hence, the Fellow can expect a comprehensive training in lid, lacrimal and orbital surgery.

There will be 2 research sessions per week during which the Fellow will be required to develop and complete several research projects in conjunction with the supervisors. Funding for presentations at an international meeting is also available. The Fellow is expected to be involved in the teaching of training registrars through tutorials and the OPD theatre.

There is also the opportunity to obtain experience in ocular oncology under the supervision of Dr Muecke as well as the possibility of rotations through the Plastics, ENT (Prof PJ Wormald) and Mohs Surgery (Dr S Huilgol) units. The Fellow also has the option of accompanying consultants on Aboriginal Eye Health Clinics in remote South Australia and possibly on overseas teaching workshops.

**Important Note:** This position is usually booked at least two years in advance. Applications sent to the above postal address or email **will not** be considered unless the following minimum requirements are met:

### **Minimum Requirements:**

- Graduate from an Ophthalmology Residency Program.

### **Overseas Applicants:**

- Applicants that come from countries where English is not considered the first language must have passed an Academic **IELTS** with an overall score of no less than 7 and a minimum of 7 in each field. IELTS test results will not be considered if they are older than two years. (*Information regarding IELTS can be found on this site under English Proficiency*).

### **Applications must include:**

- An up-to-date CV (including surgical experience and/or logbook).
- A detailed cover letter stating the position being applied for, past work experience, research interests and future plans.
- Pass Academic IELTS with overall minimum score of 7 or equivalent proof of English skills.
- Two written references from medical supervisors.
- Names, addresses, telephone, fax and email addresses of 3 referees.
- Applicant's address and contact details, including telephone, fax and email.

**Closing date for applications:** 30<sup>th</sup> April each year.
