



HONOURS BACHELOR OF MEDICAL SCIENCE STUDENTS
Florey Honours Bachelor of Medical Science Scholarship 2009

**(closing date for applications - one original & one copy
4pm on Monday 6 April 2009)**

Rules:

1. There shall be an Award called the Florey Honours Bachelor of Medical Science Scholarship.
2. The Award shall be available annually to support a medical student commencing full or part-time research through a School in the Faculty of Health Sciences for the degree of an Honours Bachelor of Medical Science at a relevant hospital, university or research institute. To be eligible a student must not hold any other Honours Scholarship.
3. The Award shall be up to \$1,500 funded jointly by the Faculty of Health Sciences and The Florey Medical Research Foundation.
4. The Award shall be made jointly by The Florey Medical Research Foundation and the Research Committee of the Faculty of Health Sciences.
5. If in a particular year there are no candidates for the Award or if there are no candidates of sufficient merit, the Award shall not be made and will be carried forward to enable multiple awards to be provided for in a future year or years.
6. These rules may be varied from time to time by agreement between The Florey Medical Research Foundation and the Executive Dean of the Health Sciences with advice from the Faculty Assoc Dean (Research).

Selection Criteria:

1. The quality and feasibility of the research proposal;
2. Referee report from the relevant Head of School;
3. Written confirmation from the Project Supervisor that he/she is prepared to supervise the student;
4. A *Curriculum Vitae* from the applicant.

Assessment:

Applications will be assessed in conjunction with the Chair of the Faculty of Health Sciences Grants and Personnel Committee and the FHS Assoc Dean (Research).
