This includes the processing of papers sent to her and ongoing library searches for your publications. To assist in the timely process please send to Kay:

1. A copy of your Journal Article (as it is published in the journal) or a list of your published papers for 2009.
2. Books and book chapters - these need front and back pages of the book. If a chapter, please send a copy of it, a full list of contents, proof of publisher and ISBN numbers (you can send Kay the whole book and it will be copied and return to you).
3. Conferences are the most difficult to submit as you will need proof your presentation was peer-reviewed, a full list of people attending and the full program.

Paediatric papers can be given to Dorothy Galuszka at the WCH Hospital for forwarding on.
