

GUIDELINES FOR DONATIONS AND BEQUESTS

Externally donated funds and bequests are used strategically to facilitate world-class breast cancer and prostate cancer research in the **Dame Roma Mitchell Cancer Research Laboratories, the University of Adelaide.**

All funds are used for research and can be specifically directed towards any or all of the following:

- Equipment (fully fund or co-contribution; plaques are placed on equipment to acknowledge the donor)
- Research scholarships (fully fund or top-up funding; naming rights can be arranged for a full scholarship)
- Research projects to leverage the donation e.g. pilot funding for early career scientists to generate critical preliminary data required to be competitive for external funding (support is recognized in all publications resulting from projects co-funded by donations)
- Strategic national and international research collaborations e.g. scientific exchanges, support visiting scientists (donor acknowledgement)
- Presentation of research at national and international meetings to communicate DRMCRL research outcomes, promote the University of Adelaide's research outputs and, if appropriate, recognize the funding support of the donor (individual or organization)
- Tissue collection, tissue banking, data management
- Other mechanisms to facilitate our research program (by negotiation between the University and the donor) to accommodate the directives / wishes of a donor (donor acknowledgement as appropriate)
