Action Research - Plan Do Study Act Review

• For situations when it is clear what needs to happen

Look & Listen, Think & Discuss, Take Action Together, Review Effectiveness
For cross cultural situations, recognising multiple perspectives, power imbalances, impact of colonisation

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Health journey mapping tools & resources


- Collaborative research, from the ground up







Meaningful approaches

- Acknowledge Aboriginal people as experts of their own lives, health and wellbeing needs and priorities
- Prioritises Aboriginal knowledges, ways of being, knowing and doing
- Flips typical colonial hierarchies on their heads e.g. community members as chief investigators
