Conversion Programs

- Seven (7) Core Courses AND five (5) Elective courses AND a capstone consisting of a professional practice placement or
- Seven (7) Core Courses AND five (5) elective courses AND a dissertation or
- Seven (7) Core Courses AND a 1 elective AND a thesis.

Extension Program

- Up to seven (7) Core Courses AND up to five (5) elective courses AND a capstone consisting of a professional practice placement OR dissertation (36 Unit extension program)
- Up to Four (4) Core Courses AND four (4) Electives AND a work-integrated research project and linked methods course (24 Unit extension program).
- Students in the extension programs will be advised about which core and elective courses they must complete depending on their previous undergraduate study.

- The Public Health specialisation comprises Core courses (18-24 Units), Electives (up to 12 Units) and Research Capstone courses (12 Units) with an option for a Professional Practice (12 units) or Dissertation (12 Units) or a Thesis (24 Units)
