

To fulfil the requirement for an English major, you must complete 24 units of study with:

- two courses (6 units) at level I
- two courses (6 units) at level II
- three courses (12 units) at level III including the capstone.

Note: Prior to 2016 some of the Level III courses had Level II (2xxx) course codes. If you have completed one of these courses in 2014 or 2015 you cannot enrol in it again. Any courses with 2xxx code completed prior to 2016 will still be counted towards Level III requirements for this major.
