- A total of 72 units are required to complete the Bachelor of Psychological Science program.
- Level I courses to the value of **no more than 24 units**, of which 12 units are Psychology core courses.
- Level II courses to the value of **no more than 24 units**, of which 15 units are Psychology core courses.
- Level III courses to the value of **no more than 24 units**, of which 12 units are Psychology core courses including the Core PSYCHOL 3020.
