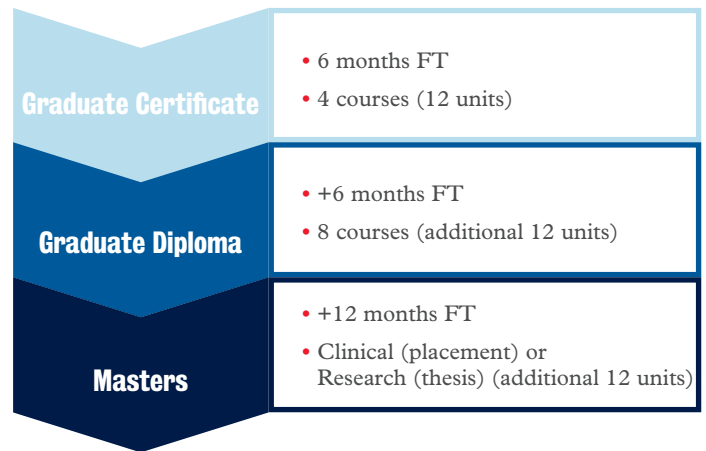

## Accreditation

Our Graduate Diploma is accredited with the Australian Counselling Association, enabling you to become a member of this professional body upon completion of the program.

Our Masters program is accredited with both the Australian Counselling Association and the Psychotherapy and Counselling Federation of Australia, enabling you to become a member of both professional bodies upon completion of the program.

## Selection Criteria

- Applicants to the Graduate Certificate must either hold a completed Bachelors Degree or equivalent, or have relevant work experience of 5 years or more in the helping professions.
- Applicants to the Graduate Diploma and Masters must have a completed a Bachelors Degree or equivalent (e.g. postgraduate study).

International applicants must satisfy English Language Requirements for the course through any of the following:

The University also accepts the Occupational English Test (OET) - a minimum result of B/score of 350 in each of the four components (listening, reading, writing and speaking). A range of alternative qualifications may meet the University's minimum English requirements.

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## How to Apply

Domestic applicants must **apply via SATAC**.

International applicants must apply via [international.adelaide.edu.au/how-to-apply](https://international.adelaide.edu.au/how-to-apply)

### All applicants must also :

- Provide a comprehensive resume/CV (this must be uploaded as part of the SATAC application)
- Attend an interview.

## General Eligibility for Placements

Students enrolled in the Masters Program who undertake clinical placements or research projects involving children or people who are ill, elderly, or vulnerable are required to demonstrate clearance by producing a criminal history check, obtained through a Department for Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI). International students are required to obtain a certificate from their home country.

## Quotas and Ranking

Quotas apply. If the number of applicants exceeds the number of places available, applicants will be ranked according to a standardised interview assessment process and the University will offer places in order of rank.

## Interview

Interviews are preferably conducted face to face in South Australia at The University of Adelaide's Health & Medical Sciences building. However, interstate or overseas applicants may request their interview be conducted online via video conferencing. The interview will include a number of questions relevant to counselling practice, and typically takes 15-20 minutes. Upon completion, outcomes will be processed via SATAC.

If you are eligible, you will be able to book an interview from a selection of times within the defined interview period on a first come, first served basis. Whilst the booking system is open, you can cancel and reschedule your interview.

## Key Dates

Domestic SATAC applications will close in late January 2021.

International SATAC applications will close in mid October 2020.

Round 1 interviews will take place in late November to early December 2020, with offers being made shortly afterwards.

Round 2 interviews will be conducted in mid-January to early February 2021 for domestic applicants only.
