2022 Enrolment Cheat Sheet Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery Year 3



Enrolment Order

You need to enrol into your courses in the following order to ensure that you do not have any timetable clashes. Follow links in your <u>Study Plan</u> to view course/class information in <u>Course Planner</u>. All enrolment occurs through <u>Access Adelaide</u>. Enrol into Semester 1 prior to Semester 2. Enrolment in all courses is compulsory.

Semester 1 Order:

- 1. MEDIC ST 3101A Scientific Basis of Medicine III Part 1: Enrol into tutorial, choose one resource class, and the lecture class.
- MEDIC ST 3102AHO Clinical Practice III Part 1: You will need to enrol into the group corresponding with your clinical placement (hospital) allocation in Sonia. Ensure that you read all notes on Course Planner. A note will appear at the bottom of each group to identify the group that corresponds with your placement location.
 Eg. Note: For students who are allocated RAH for their clinical placement. Enrol in the same Seminar group in both semesters.
 You must choose the correct group for your hospital allocation and enrol in the same seminar class (see section number) for Semester 1 and Semester 2 (eq SE03)
- 3. MEDIC ST 3103A Medical Professional and Personal Development III Part 1: Enrol into lecture, choose one practical class.
- MEDIC ST 3104A/MEDIC ST 3104AOL* Research and Critical Appraisal Part 1: Enrol into lecture class. *Denotes online course option.
- 5. MEDIC ST 3000A Third Year MBBS Examination Part 1: Select available class.

In total, 5 enrolments for Semester 1

Semester 2 Order:

- 1. MEDIC ST 3101B Scientific Basis of Medicine III Part 2: Enrol into tutorial, choose one resource, and the lecture class.
- MEDIC ST 3102BHO Clinical Practice III Part 2: You will need to enrol in this course as per your clinical placement (hospital) allocation in Sonia. Ensure that you read all notes on Course Planner. You must choose the correct group for your hospital allocation and enrol in the same seminar class (see section number) for Semester 1 and Semester 2 (eg SE03).
- MEDIC ST 3103B Medical Professional and Personal Development III Part 2: Enrol into practical, choose one tutorial class.
- MEDIC ST 3104B/MEDIC ST 3104BOL* Research and Critical Appraisal Part 2: Enrol into lecture class. *Denotes online course option.
- 5. MEDIC ST 3000B Third Year MBBS Examination Part 2: Select available class.

In total, 5 enrolments for Semester 2

If you enrol into a class that clashes with other classes or courses you are already enrolled in, an error message will be displayed along with the clashing class numbers and an enrolment request ID.

Please attempt to resolve this by ensuring you have followed the enrolment advice above, or choose a different class for one that is clashing (if applicable).

For enrolment issues you cannot resolve yourself, please lodge the relevant <u>enrolment form</u> (eg. Timetable clash resolution, course/class full, course add – late, amendment to enrolment).

When enrolling please make note of the locations of all of your classes, as locations are in the Adelaide Health and Medical Sciences (AHMS) Building and also on Main Campus. You need to allow for time between classes to travel between AHMS and Main Campus, as applicable.
