Enrolment Order

You need to enrol into your courses in the following order to ensure that you do not have any timetable clashes. Follow links in your [Study Plan](#) to view course/class information in [Course Planner](#). All enrolment occurs through [Access Adelaide](#).

Enrol into Semester 1 prior to Semester 2. Enrolment in all courses is compulsory.

Semester 1 Order:

6. MEDIC ST 6020AHO – Psychiatry Selective VI Part 1.
7. MEDIC ST 6021AHO – Surgery Selective VI Part 1

9. MEDIC ST 6000A – Sixth Year Examination Part 1

In total, 9 enrolments for Semester 1.

Semester 2 Order:

1. MEDIC ST 6015BHO – Medicine Internship VI Part 2
2. MEDIC ST 6016BHO – Surgery Internship VI Part 2
3. MEDIC ST 6017BHO – Emergency Department Internship VI Part 2
4. MEDIC ST 6018BHO – Medicine Selective VI Part 2
5. MEDIC ST 6019BHO – Primary Care Selective VI Part 2
6. MEDIC ST 6020BHO – Psychiatry Selective VI Part 2
7. MEDIC ST 6021BHO – Surgery Selective VI Part 2
8. MEDIC ST 6022BHO – Transition to Internship Part 2
9. MEDIC ST 6000B – Sixth Year Examination Part 2

In total, 9 enrolments for Semester 2.

IMPORTANT - You must enrol in Semester 1 and 2 for all courses, regardless of whether you are allocated placement for that course in only one semester.

For courses in which you need to match your classes with your allocated placement dates/location (as allocated in Sonia), there is a note at the bottom of the class information in Course Planner to help identify your relevant class.

If you are undertaking a placement in Semester 1, you must enrol per your placement allocation in the Semester 1 course, and then into the shell class for the corresponding Semester 2 course, or vice versa.

For example – Student A is allocated to Psychiatry Selective placement in Semester 1 with rotation commencing on 9 May.

In Semester 1, Student A would enrol into the Psychiatry Selective VI Part 1 class that corresponds with their placement, per the following class note:

Note: For students who are allocated Psychiatry Selective placement from 9 May to 5 June.

In Semester 2, Student A would enrol into the shell class for Psychiatry Selective VI Part 2, with the following class note:

Note: For students who are allocated to a Psychiatry Selective placement in SEMESTER ONE between 17 January and 5 June.

IMPORTANT: The Transition to Internship program is attended during your internship semester only, so you must enrol into classes for this course in your internship semester and into the shell class for this course in your selective semester.

If you enrol into a class that clashes with other classes or courses you are already enrolled in, an error message will be displayed along with the clashing class numbers and an enrolment request ID.

Please attempt to resolve this by ensuring you have followed the enrolment advice above, or choose a different class for one that is clashing (if applicable).

For enrolment issues you cannot resolve yourself, please lodge the relevant [enrolment form](#) (eg. Timetable clash resolution, course/class full, course add – late, amendment to enrolment).
